




United Nations Freshwater Availability Map

The Measurement of Water Law All water supplied/consumed, has to be measured










The Desalination Revolution

> Water from various water sources is supplied in a short time without storage capabilities A huge operational challenge




Effluent Reclamation

- Israel reuses more than 85% of the treated effluents
- Israel's strategic goal for the next decade is to increase the reuse to 90%




- Controlled pumping while maintaining the groundwater level & quality

Managing the entire national water system






- monitoring 3,000 facilities in real-time by remote control.

3% Water Loss
