- Scientific coordination: The Cyprus Institute (Cyl)


Outcomes:

Water Task Force-EMME Climate Change Initiative


- The Water Task Force report monitors the current state of water resources across the EMME, emphasizing the profound challenges posed by a changing climate.
- This report critically reviews existing national climate change adaptation strategies, evaluating the efficacy of water policies and measures implemented by countries in the region.
- Key findings from the report reveal big gaps in research, policy frameworks, and overall knowledge concerning climate adaptation within the water sector: these gaps affect the development and implementation of solutions to safeguard water resources for future generations.

Addressing these challenges is crucial for developing resilient water management strategies and ensuring long-term water security in this vulnerable region.




